PLUS THE FOLLOWING CORE ELEMENTS (1 POINT EACH)

TOK **THEORY OF KNOWLEDGE (TOK)**
100-hour programme taught over two years about critical thinking and inquiry into the nature of knowledge. It is assessed through an exhibition and a 1600-word essay.

CAS **CREATIVITY, ACTIVITY & SERVICE (CAS)**
Students take part in a range of experiences and at least one project, often involving music, drama, sport, service in the local community and collaboration with our partner schools.

EE **EXTENDED ESSAY (EE)**
4000-word independent research essay into a topic that the student has a particular interest or passion in.

PLUS AN OPTIONAL EXTENDED PROJECT QUALIFICATION (EPQ)

Equivalent to 50% of an A-Level

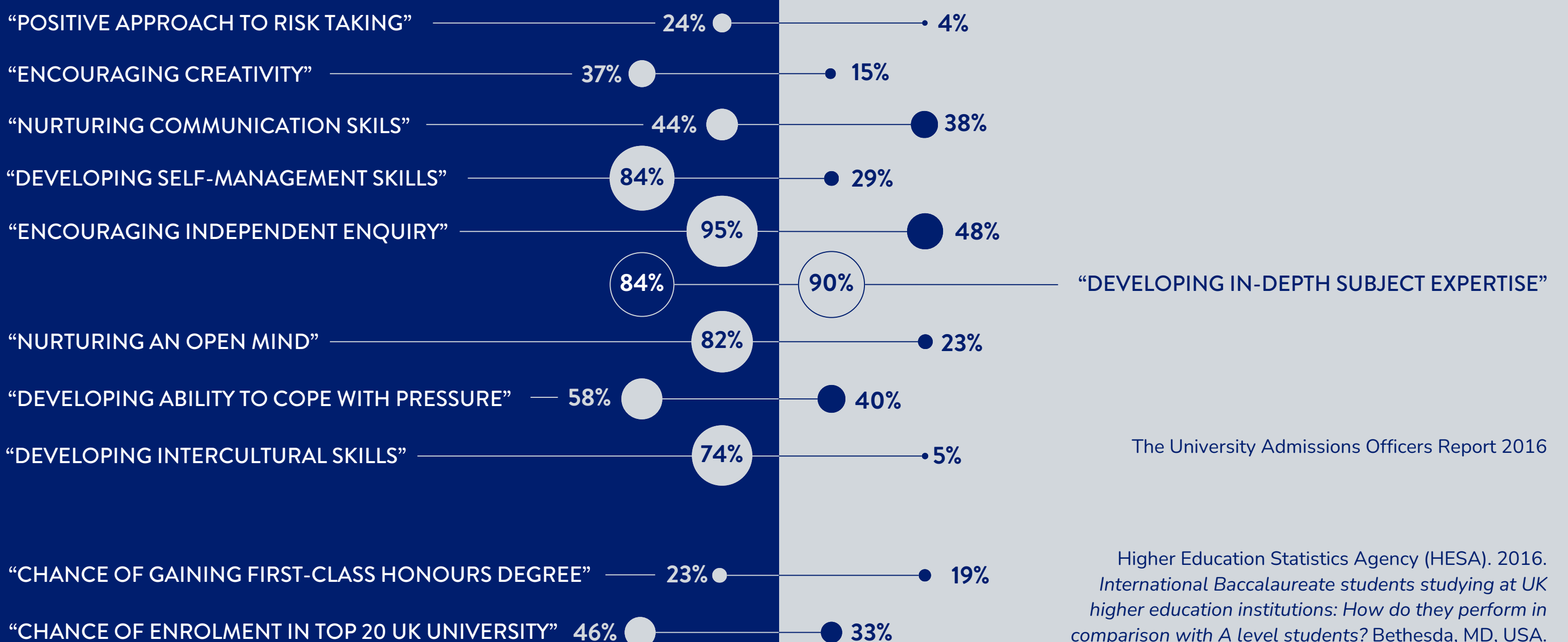
