Application fee (non-refundable)

Parent questionnaire form – completed by student's parent/s

Early Childhood questionnaire – completed by student's parent/s

Pre-K and Kindergarten students – complete Pre-K to Grade 3 student questionnaire

Teacher reference forms – completed by student's classroom teacher if the child has already attended nursery/pre-school/school and the Head of School/Nursery

Any school records issued to date, if applicable

Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), 504 plan, psychological assessments, occupational therapy, speech & language reports or medical reports

Any other available records or information regarding any support received in school

Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for right to study in the UK before the start of school.

GRADES 1-4 (AGES 6-10)

Application fee (non-refundable)

School records from previous three years (all terms/semesters), including the current year, and any standardised test results

Parent questionnaire form – completed by student's parent/s

Student questionnaire:

Grades 1, 2 & 3 – complete PreK to Grade 3 student questionnaire

Grade 4 – complete Grade 4 student questionnaire

Two teacher reference forms – completed by student's current teacher and the Head of School/Head of Year. Should the applicant receive any learning support at school, we would require a reference form to be completed by the learning support teacher as well

Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), 504 plan, psychological assessments, occupational therapy, speech & language reports or medical reports

Any other available records or information regarding any support received in school

Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for right to study in the UK before the start of school.



GRADES 5-7 (AGES 10-14)

Application fee (non-refundable)

School records from previous three years (all terms/semesters), including the current year, and any standardised test results

Parent questionnaire form – completed by student's parent/s

Student questionnaire – student to complete Grades 5 to 7 student questionnaire

Two teacher reference forms – one to be completed by student's current teacher/s (preferably Maths or English) and one to be completed by the Head of School/Head of Year. Should the applicant receive any learning support at school, we would require a reference form to be completed by the learning support teacher as well

Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), 504 plan, psychological assessments, occupational therapy, speech & language reports or medical reports

Any other available records or information regarding any support received in school

English as an Additional Language (EAL) testing may be required for grade 7 students

Any available EAL test results

Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for right to study in the UK before the start of school.

GRADES 8-12 (AGES 14-18)

Application fee (non-refundable)

School records from previous three years (all terms/semesters), including the current year, and any standardised test results

Parent questionnaire form – completed by student's parent/s

Student questionnaire – students to complete Grades 8 to 12 student questionnaire

Two teacher reference forms – one to be completed by student's current teacher/s (preferably Maths or English) and one to be completed by the Head of School/Head of Year. Should the applicant receive any learning support at school, we would require a reference form to be completed by the learning support teacher as well

Any Individual Education Plans (IEP), 504 plan, psychological assessments, occupational therapy, speech & language reports or medical reports

Any other available records or information regarding any support received in school

Any available EAL assessments such as IELTS or Cambridge PET/FCE

Further English as an Additional Language (EAL) testing may be required

Grade 9 and 10 students applying to start mid-year to complete preliminary course planner form

All Grade 11 and 12 applicants to complete preliminary course planner form to indicate pathways of interest.

Copy of the student's passport on application and relevant visa for right to study in the UK before the start of school.
