COLLEGE COUNSELLING PROGRAMME

Our university and college counsellors work with each student individually to offer bespoke, expert provision to meet a student's needs by giving value to their individual strengths. From Grade 10 (aged 15/16) onwards the students begin to explore opportunities, are advised on subject selection and are guided through the application process by their nominated counsellor. The counsellors maximise student opportunities providing comprehensive, honest information that will allow students and families to make informed decisions and find the "best fit" university or pathway.

Our counsellors have a wealth of experience working with a breadth of universities and colleges around the world navigating challenging admission requirements and advocating for students. Each year students attend world-class colleges and universities in the UK, the US and around the world, with the majority going to the UK and the US. Counsellors support students in the following ways:

- One-to-one sessions with students (and parents if requested)
- University and College visits and fairs
- Skills workshops
